CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE RIDING PONYSTUD BOOK SOCIETY LTD HAVE BEEN UPDATED ON THE NATIONAL WEBSITE

www.rpsbs.com.au

1. Entries will be received by the Show Secretary & subject to the rules and regulations of the RPSBS Ltd.
2. Exhibitors shall abide by the rules & regulations of the RPSBS Ltd and those hereinafter set out.
3. All exhibitors shall be bound by and observe the decisions of the ground jury.
4. The show ground jury reserves the right to adjudicate upon entry or upon any dispute or doubt and to make any determination up on any matter and this decision shall be final and not subject to appeal of any kind. Disputes/protests must be lodged in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the class, together with a deposit of \$50.00 refundable if the protest is upheld.
5. The Society shall have the power without assigning any reason to:
 - Reject or cancel any entry at any time
 - Cancel any event or class
 - Remove any exhibit from the show grounds
 - Transfer an exhibit or exhibitor from any class to another class
 - Add to or alter the program as necessary
 - Combine classes if there are insufficient entries
6. The Society shall not be responsible for the loss or for any damage or injury occasioned to any exhibit or the property of any exhibitor from any cause whatsoever.
7. The Exhibitor enters entirely at his/her own risk. Insurance rules apply, see below.
8. In case any exhibit whilst on the Society's show ground shall cause or be the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibit or exhibitor, to the person or property of any member of the Society or general public, the owner of such exhibit shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Society, its officers, officials and members, from and against all damages, costs, claims, expenses or liabilities incurred in connection with such exhibitors. The exhibitor shall be liable to the Society and its employees, officers and officials for any damage or loss occasioned to any of them by the exhibitor or his agent.
9. All ponies four years and over must be adult registered.
10. All ponies under four years must either be adult registered or foal recorded.
11. All ponies competing must be visibly branded and registered with the RPSBS Ltd., and owners/exhibitors must be current financial members of the Society.
12. Ponies cannot be shown under saddle until three years of age.
13. Handlers and riders of stallions and colts must be 18 years of age and over.
14. All ponies are required to be measured. Current measuring certificates issued by any Equestrian Australia, or any Royal Show will be accepted. This rule is State specific so please check with State Secretary.
15. There is to be no change of handler once a class has commenced without the permission of the judge.
16. The Judge's decision will be final.
17. No person shall in any way consult or interfere with or attempt to interfere with the Judge or endeavor to Interfere with the Judges freedom of choice or judgment.
18. The Society may alter the Judge for any particular event at any time it deems fit.
19. Approved ASSA helmets must be worn at all times whilst riding. Any injury sustained by a person riding and not wearing an approved ASSA helmet will not be covered by any liability claim or by insurance.
20. A fall of a horse and/or rider in a ridden event will result in disqualification from that event.
21. A rider must NOT remount in the show ring following a fall.
22. Random swabbing may take place.
23. RPSBS Ltd. membership and registration certificates must be with the owner/exhibitor on the day of the show and must be made available on request.
24. No pending registrations, no late memberships will be accepted.
25. Newcomer Rules are State Specific check with State Secretary;
 - Each pony must have a current Newcomer Card which must be given to the Ring Steward when entering the ring.
 - If the competitor does not produce their Newcomer Card they will not be able to compete.
 - Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bit.
 - Any pony that has entered the Newcomer Competition under their State specific rules is eligible to compete at the National Newcomer event.
 - All newcomer finalist will be eligible for the RPSBS Victorian Newcomer final held at Barastoc 2012
26. The Wilkie snaffle or the Baucher bit is not permitted to be used in Lead Rein or First Ridden classes.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY CONTINUED

PROTESTS

27. A Judge may lodge a protest against an exhibitor alleging infringement of the Rules.
28. Protest must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary or
29. Lodged in writing to the secretary, The Riding Pony Society.
30. An exhibitor or show official may lodge a protest against a competitor/ Judge alleging infringement of the Rules.
31. Protests must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary, accompanying a deposit of \$100 which may be forfeited to the secretary if the protest be unfounded or frivolous or
32. Lodged in writing with the Secretary of the Riding Pony Society
33. It is at the Committee's discretion that further action be taken over a protest.
34. The Committee now has a sub committee in place to deal with protests.
35. Any person who has a protest lodged against him/her has the right of reply in defense.
36. Any expense incurred by any parties to the said protests shall be borne by the person/s concerned.

HOME PRODUCED

HOME PRODUCED CLASSES RELY ON THE INTEGRITY AND GOODWILL OF EXHIBITORS IN ADHERENCE TO ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

37. For the purposes of these rules a "Professional" is deemed to be someone who receives an income from the production or showing of horses, and/or a person who produces or shows horses for a fee.
38. Any horse competing in Home Produced classes cannot, in the current financial year, have been produced by someone considered to be a professional, or in a professional establishment except on a DIY basis.
39. Any horse competing in Home Produced classes must not have been shown in hand or under saddle by a rider or handler who has shown for a professional at any show in the current financial year. (NB. Riders and handlers under the age of 14 years and 9 months are exempt from this rule)

ALL CHEQUES MADE PAYABLE: - Riding Pony Stud Book Society Victorian Committee

Please ensure entries are correct and complete; incorrect entries will be returned and incur an **\$11.00 Administration Fee.**

Insurance forms only need to be completed if they were not completed with your membership renewal in July 2010 or you have a non-member riding PLEASE check with the Secretary if you are unsure.

Members Release and Waiver of Liability **MUST** be completed by all riders, handler, owners, strappers of ponies into the National Show, who are members of the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd, EA or any other organisation insured through the EA.

Non Members Release and Waiver of Liability **MUST** be completed by all riders, handler, owners, strappers of ponies into the National Show, who are NOT members of the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd, EA or any other organisation insured through the EA.

A PHOTOCOPY OF THE EXHIBITS REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE AND THE EXHIBITORS CURRENT MEMBERSHIP CARD MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES. FAILING TO DO SO WILL DEEM THE ENTRY INCORRECT. MEMBERSHIP AND PONY REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST BE WITH THE OWNER.

If you are not a current financial member of the RPSBS Ltd, Equestrian Australia or any affiliated Society with Equestrian Australia, you must pay the \$20.00 Public Liability Insurance cover for the day or your entries will not be accepted. This also applies to any person assisting competitors on the day. All members and non-members are required to fill out the attached insurance forms.

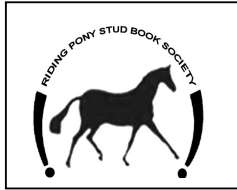

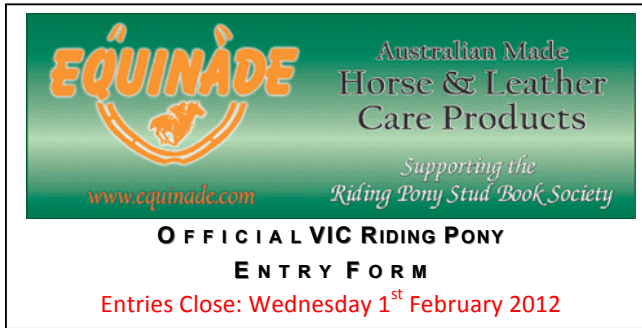
