All Competitors Compete at Own Risk

All competitors must sign the indemnity form. Non-Members to pay \$10 levy. The form will be available at the ticket office. NO FORM completed, NO ENTRY TO EVENTS.

The names and addresses (fax and email) will be requested at the start of the day for send of future schedules. Please ensure that the horses' names are correct so results will be correct. The Murray-Loddon Promotional Group is insured with the APSB/EFA and we are abiding by their rules. Please note that Membership Cards and Papers will be required for inspection. The **Judges** decision is final. No protests will be accepted. Places will be awarded at the Judges discretion. There will be no measuring on the day.

Riding Pony Stud Book Society Rules for Qualifying Show Program for Champion of Champion at the Riding Pony Classic.

Ring 5 is sponsored by the Riding Pony Society. All ponies must be registered with the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Inc. Ponies must be shown in the registered owner's name. Registration certificates and membership cards must be produced on request. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification from classes. Ridden ponies must be over 3 years.

There are a limited number of stables available for exhibitors who wish to camp overnight. Please contact the Secretary to ensure that stables are still available.

Show hunters may only compete in Hunter classes. You must choose between Open Classes and Show Hunter.
