CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR RIDING PONY SHOWS

- 1 Entries shall be received by the Secretary subject to the rules and regulations of the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd. and those hereinafter set out.
- 2 Exhibitors shall at all times abide by the rules and conditions as laid down by the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd
- 3 All entry forms to be signed by the RESPONSIBLE OFFICER for the exhibit.
- 4 All exhibitors shall be bound by and observe the decisions of the show sub committee.
- 5 The Society/sub/committee reserves the right to adjudicate upon entry or upon any dispute or doubt and to make any determination upon any matter and this decision shall be final and not subject to appeal of any kind.
- 6 The Society shall have the power without assigning any reason to:-
 - a Reject or cancel any entry at any time
 - b Cancel any event or class
 - c Remove any exhibit from the showgrounds
 - d Transfer an exhibit or exhibitor from any class to another
 - e Add to or alter the program as necessary
 - f Combine classes if there are insufficient entries
- 7 The Society shall not be responsible for the loss or for any damage or injury occasioned to any exhibit or the property of any exhibitor from any cause whatsoever.
- 8 The Exhibitor enters entirely at his/her own risk.
- 9 In case any exhibit whilst on the Society's showgrounds shall cause or to be the cause of injury or damage to any other exhibit or exhibitor, to the person or property of any member of the Society or general public, the owner as such exhibit shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Society, its officers, officials and members, from and against all damages, costs, claims, and expenses or liabilities incurred in connection with such exhibitors. The exhibitor shall be liable to the Society and its employees and officials for any damage loss occasioned to any of them by the exhibitor or his agent.
- 10 All ponies 4 years and over must be adult registered.
- 11 All ponies under 4 years must be adult registered or foal recorded.
- 12 All ponies competing must be visibly branded and registered with the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd. and owners/exhibitors must be current financial members.
- 13 Brood mares must be in possession of a Pregnancy Certificate or have a foal at foot.
- 14 Brood mares are NOT eligible for Dry mare classes.
- 15 Brood mares with foals at foot are ineligible for ridden classes.
- 16 Ponies cannot be shown under saddle until 3 years of age.
- 17 Handlers and riders of stallions and colts are to be over 18 years of age.
- 18 All ponies shall be measured. Other current measuring from the EFA, Hack Council and Royal Shows will be accepted.
- 19 Competitors are NOT permitted to leave class without the Judge's permission.
- 20 There is to be NO change of handler once the class has commenced without permission of the Judge.
- 21 Riders will not be permitted to remount a pony in the show ring after a fall, resulting in disqualification from that class.
- 22 The Judge's decision shall be final.
- 23 No person shall in any way consult or interfere with or attempt to interfere with the Judge or endeavour to interfere with the Judge's freedom of choice of judgement.
- 24 The Society may alter the Judge for any particular event at any time it deems fit.
- 25 Approved ASSA helmets must be worn. Any injury sustained by a person riding and not wearing an approved safety helmet will not be covered by any liability claim or by insurance.
- 26 Random swabbing will take place.
- 27 The ground, ringmaster, judge or ring steward is able to remove a pony from competing that is deemed a danger to the handler, rider, competition or general public.

PROTESTS

1. A Judge may lodge a protest against an exhibitor alleging infringement of the Rules.
 - (a) Protest must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary or
 - (b) Lodged in writing to the secretary, The Riding Pony Society.
2. An exhibitor or show official may lodge a protest against a competitor/Judge alleging infringement of the Rules.
 - (a) Protests must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary, accompanying a deposit of \$50 which may be forfeited to the secretary if the protest be unfounded or frivolous or
 - (b) Lodged in writing with the Secretary of the Riding Pony Society
3. It is at the Committee's discretion that further action be taken over a protest.
 - (a) The Committee now has a sub committee in place to deal with protests.
4. Any person who has a protest lodged against him/her has the right of reply in defence.
5. Any expense incurred by any parties to the said protests shall be borne by the person/s concerned.

WORKING HUNTERS

These classes are open to ponies (mares/geldings/stallions) 4 years old and over.

These classes have two phases

First the ponies must jump a course of not less that six natural looking fences of a maximum height according to the class.

Following this they are judged on conformation, action, ride etc. As in the Show Hunter class.

Generally the type required is much the same as a show hunter but may exhibit slightly less quality with more substance, and obviously able to carry a child across a cross-country ride, where small fences, logs and ditches would be jumped. It is up to the judge to decide how much emphasis should be placed on type and how much on performance. However the pony must exhibit an ability to jump and be fit enough to go a distance. Over fat ponies should be scored down.

The jumping phase is always judged first and there are 50 marks for jumping.

10 for style and manners while jumping

Knocking down a fence incurs 10 penalties:

The first refusal costs 15 penalties,

The second 20,

The third disqualification.

A complete turn in front of the fence counts as a refusal.

A fall of horse or rider incurs disqualification, In the jumping phase judges expect the ponies to jump the course fluently and smoothly, neither going right into the bottom of the fences, nor standing too far off.

As manners are taken into account, pulling, jibbing or a disobedience of any kind will be penalized.

The second phase is judged as a Show Hunter class but with definite points allotted. Conformation and freedom of action carry a maximum of 30 marks, Manners 10 marks. Included in the second round are at least all ponies which have jumped a clear round or had only 10 faults plus whatever others the judges choose to include apart from those eliminated in the first phase.

Competitors are not permitted to change saddlery between the first and second phases. It is not necessary to use a jumping saddle; in fact some judges believe they cover up too much of the shoulder and neck to make a proper assessment, so the type of saddle that is acceptable for Show Hunter classes will suffice.

A martingale may be used.

Boots of a plain color, may be used for Phase 1

No bandages or protective pads on ponies legs are permissible.

N.B. Whips are not considered tack.

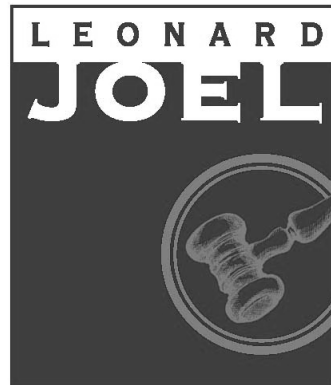

Rules & Regulations

Ponies are to be ridden or led by an amateur owner. **Owner** means the person or one of the people who is noted on the Registration Certificate of the RPSBS Ltd as the Owner or Lessee of the Pony or a member of that persons immediate family. Where ponies are registered in more than one name, all parties be eligible for amateur status for the pony to compete. **Amateur** means, regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is considered an amateur who meets the criteria listed below, and is a current member of the RPSBS Ltd.

A Professional is an adult 18yrs & over who, in the past three (3) years:

1. Has accepted remuneration directly or indirectly for breaking, riding, training, schooling, driving, halter preparation, showing in halter or under saddle.
 2. Has accepted remuneration for conducting clinics or seminars or given instruction in showing, training or riding.
 3. Has performed any of the above list of activities for which another person in his/her family or corporation which a member of his/her family controls, will receive remuneration directly or indirectly.
 4. Has performed such activities while accepting remuneration directly or indirectly for employment in another capacity for an employer or member of the said employer's family who owns, boards or trains the involved horse.
 5. Has ridden, driven or exhibited in horse shows any horse he/she or a member of his/her family accepts remuneration directly or indirectly for boarding or training.
- The following activities shall not affect the amateur owner status of a person who is otherwise qualified:**
6. The writing of books/articles pertaining to horses.
 7. Accepting remuneration for judging or stewarding.
 8. Speaking at workshops, clinics, seminars or youth training days in a voluntary capacity where they do not accept fees for their services.
 9. Receiving prize money.
 10. Having the occupation of farrier, veterinarian, thoroughbred trainer or trotting training.
 11. Owning or operating a saddlery, stud or breeding farm or boarding stables.

Rule Explanation:

Basically, the rule means that anyone who is employed by a training establishment to do duties other than riding, breaking, training, schooling, driving, showing or preparing ponies is eligible to be an amateur. Spouses and immediate family of a trainer are also able to be an amateur as long as they are not involved with the breaking, training, schooling, riding or showing of any of the horses the trainer is being paid to work with. People who board horses are eligible for amateur status as long as they do not ride, show, train or do any of the tasks in 1-5 of the rule, for the boarders. If they did, they would be involved in receiving remuneration indirectly for those tasks upon payment of boarding fees. If you are not being paid money for any of those tasks in 1-5 of the rules, but are exchanging goods or services for those tasks you would also be seen to be receiving remuneration indirectly. Halter preparation has been included as a professional service as those preparing halter horses are being paid for their duties in the same manner someone would be paid to train and/or show a horse under saddle. An Amateur is able to show someone else's horse on occasion, in special circumstances, as long as it is as a favour and they receive no reward
